I attended the Little Athletics Conference in Coxs Harbour in July 2024 which was a good opportunity to learn about some of this and share experiences with other clubs.

The club has continued to do well again this year. Our registration numbers were up slightly, and we were successful in attracting sponsorship from local businesses. We ended the year in good shape, with happy kids and a healthy bank balance, even though we ran at a slight financial loss.

There have been many highlights this year. We ran a fun relay night before Christmas with 10 double passes donated from the Central Coast Aquapark given out as prizes. There were plenty of inter-club carnivals and competitions across the state where athletes competed far and wide. We have decided to create a new award for club ambassadors to acknowledge athletes who compete in multiple events over the season. This year forty-two athletes also competed at Zone, Regional and NSW State Championships, which were held over two weekends at Sydney Olympic Park this year for the first time. I congratulate all those athletes for their enthusiasm and to the parents who assist. We ended the season with some fun dress-ups and games on our last night.

I would like to thank the committee members. We had a number of new members, Jade Smith as Secretary, Holly Ashford as Treasurer and Nancy Broen on results. The new energy you bring the club is valued. Thank you to ongoing committee members including Raewyn Burden our competent registrar, who managed a new registration platform this year. Jet James for support as club as Vice President. Zoe Brookes who moved from Secretary to canteen, who not only fed the hungry masses on Friday nights but also raised much needed funds for our club. 3.3 Treasurers Report

During the season we have had steady, well-balanced accounts for both our working and canteen accounts. Our club remains in a healthy financial position as we carry over to next season.

Following the closure of the season, our accounts have been audited by Meany and Associates and all requested and required financial reports are included at the end of this report.

This season we saw a rise in our registrations, canteen sales and sponsorships. The total income being \$30,909.61 which has increased from our previous total income of \$26,702.50 in the previous year. Surplus funds went into a fixed term deposit earning \$1,394.39 in interest.

Our expenses increased from the previous season partially due to costs associated with last year's presentation and payment for two seasons ground fees included this year. Depreciation of a laptop purchased was taken up in full as an end of year adjustment by the accountant. Total expenses for the year were \$36,268.24 increasing from \$28,947.21 the previous year. Noting these figures and factors above, our club ended the season in a deficit of \$6,414.80

I would like to focus on additional fundraising, seeking sponsorships, training commitments and costs and my main hope is to be able to maintain affordable registration fees for all, whilst being able to ensure our finances sit steady for stability.

Overall, as we close off the 24/25 season and enter the 25/26 season, I believe we are sitting with a healthy bank balance and cash flow that will continue to ensure WWPLAC runs smoothly.

I would like to thank all committee members, volunteers, and families for their continued support they show WWPLAC. It has been a pleasure to be on the committee for the 24/25 athletics season. A special mention to our Chris, who each week has continued to put her time and guidance in ensuring the club is able to run. Chris has been a valuable committee member, who shows outstanding leadership and passion for Little Athletics and has played a crucial role for the club and its community. Thank you, Chris!

3.4 Registrar Report

As we wrap up another fantastic season, I'm thrilled to share some highlights and updates with you all. This year, we maintained a steady number of 215 enthusiastic athletes, with a mix of 48% girls and 52% boys. It's heartening to see the boys stepping up their numbers after domination of the girls in previous years!

The 6-10 age range is nearly 70% of our club. It's fantastic to see so many young athletes developing their skills

and having fun. However, as a club, we aim to encourage our athletes to continue into the older age groups. This is something we need to review with our older athletes to find ways to engage them further.

This season, we had a vibrant group of 39 seven-year-olds, making up about 18% of our total athletes, and the largest age-group. Our Under 7 Boys were the largest gender age-group this season, with 21 participants which required us to split the group to ensure all athletes received a fairer turn (and they didn't finish at midnight!).

This season, we also introduced payment plans through the new RevSport system. While we experienced initial hiccups, we are committed to ironing out these issues in the off-season. We are also exploring new ways to make payment plans even more convenient for our athletes and their families.

Thank you to all the athletes, parents, coaches, and volunteers who made this season a success. Your dedication and support are what make our club so special. I encourage parents from the 6-10 age group to consider joining the committee and volunteer roles to ensure our club thrives in future years.

There have been so many great Personal Bests this season and these have been celebrated each week as we all yell "PB for....." to delighted and tired athletes as they finish their events.

This year the criteria for awarding trophies have been reviewed and the 'The WWPLAC Trophy Criteria' updated to provide more clarity on how decisions are made. Records and Ranking results have been used in deciding the Perpetual Awards as well as the allocations of Age Championship trophies, and it is a testament to our athletes as well as the dedication of their families and our Committee and volunteers that we see these great achievements. Well done to everyone for their efforts!

Sharing this role between us has again been a great way for two busy women to enjoy and juggle the job. As Mums, we have both enjoyed being in a role that lets us see our kids participate while having flexibility to manage fulltime work commitments. We encourage other people in our club to 'buddy up' if you'd like to be involved but feel you can't take on a role on your own. 3.7 Canteen Report

The 2024/25 season brought a mix of weather conditions, with several Friday nights impacted by poor weather and a few declared washouts. Despite this, the canteen remained a reliable and welcoming presence at the club.

While the core menu remained largely unchanged, we made a few small updates and introduced minor price increases in response to rising costs and general inflation. These adjustments helped us maintain financial performance throughout the season.

Weekly sales remained steady, allowing us to minimise waste and maintain a healthy profit margin. Over the season, the canteen achieved a total income of **\$6,681**, with expenses amounting to **\$2171.50**, resulting in a net profit of **\$4806.50**. Weekly takings generally ranged between **\$400 and \$600**.

A heartfelt thank you goes to my right-hand woman, Naomi Hart, for her unwavering support, infectious humour, and tireless dedication throughout the season. I'm incredibly grateful for everything she brought to the canteen week after week. Special thanks also go to Judi and Ken Plowman, Edie and Greg Llewellyn, Chris and Tom Szymanski and Ric Brookes for generously stepping in when needed. Your support made a real difference. And of course, thank you to all the last-minute helpers who jumped in to ensure everything ran smoothly.

As the season comes to a close, Naomi and I will be stepping down from our roles in the canteen. We'll truly miss the friendly faces, the kids' smiles, and the wonderful atmosphere that Friday nights at McEvoy always bring. It's been a rewarding experience, and we're grateful to have been part of it.

5.2 Keith Wilmot Award

5.4 Bob Walkley Highest Award

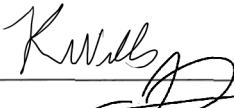

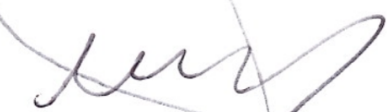
